



# Call for Applications Tenure Track Faculty Position in Mechanical Engineering Education

The Faculty of Education in Science and Technology at the Technion - Israel Institute of Technology, invites you to apply for a tenure-track faculty position in *Mechanical Engineering Education*.

**A suitable candidate with an engineering background will be eligible for a postdoctoral fellowship in the field of engineering education.**

## Candidates must hold:

- A BSc and/or MSc in **mechanical engineering, aerospace engineering, civil engineering, or a related engineering field.**
- A PhD in engineering or STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) education or equivalent degrees.

Candidates are expected to develop and lead the Mechanical Engineering Education program at the Faculty. This includes the development of advanced research projects, applying for competitive research grants, collaborating with leading researchers, supervising graduate students, and teaching courses.

## Candidates are invited to submit a single PDF file with the following documents in English:

- Cover letter with name, current affiliation, and contact information.
- Curriculum vitae, including a list of publications.
- Statement of research interests in engineering education (two pages).
- Statement of teaching philosophy and community service (one page).
- Representative publications.
- A list of three referees and their contact information.
