JOB SUMMARY: To plan, organize and implement an appropriate instructional program in an elementary learning environment that guides and encourages children to develop and fulfill their academic potential.

Roles and responsibilities:

1. Create positive educational climate for students to learn in.
2. Create lesson plans and instructional resources and modify accordingly throughout the year, for use in the classroom.
3. Actual teaching – Accompany and support learning processes for the children as individuals and as a group,
4. Integrate competencies, goals, and objectives into lesson plans.
5. Utilize curricula that reflect the diverse educational, cultural, and linguistic backgrounds of the children served.
6. Perform administrative duties as needed.
7. Observe and evaluate children's performance.
8. Establishing a social framework according to the needs of the children and their parents based on the local conditions.
9. Serve as liaison with the parents and other agencies involved.

13. A warm and loving figure for the children
